



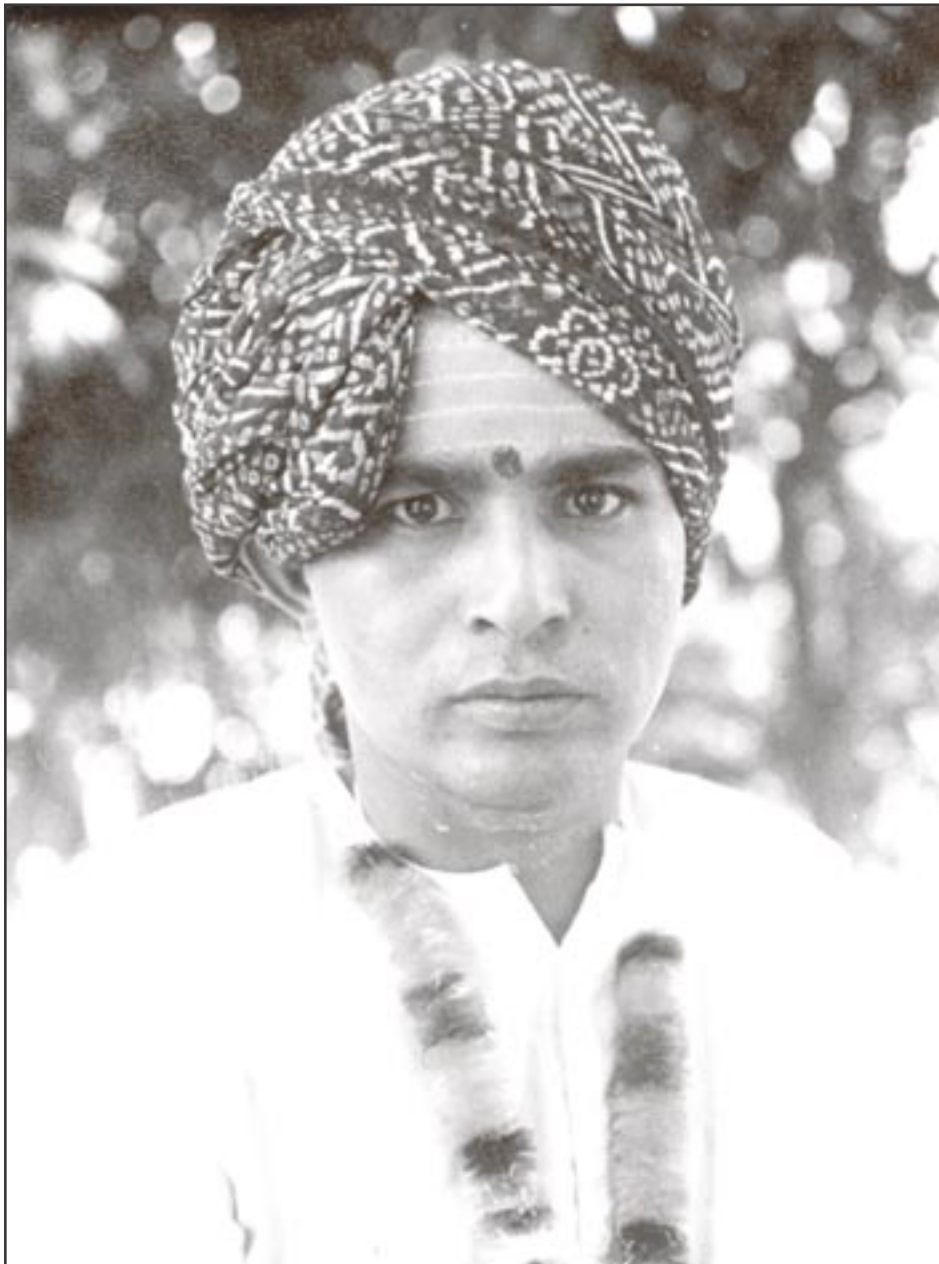

## President Lok's Message



The world is at war in Iraq. We do not know what the ultimate cost will be in human life, to the environment, or to international relationships. For that we must join other faith communities in waiting, prayer, and hope.

Conflicts and confusion were a daily reality around Babaji - little wars. They ranged from inner ego battles to power struggles around status with Babaji, rooms, and work projects. Baba was never one to avoid, cover up, or make nice the darker emotions and energies of our human experience. He would masterfully play people into conflict and confronting their own.

At the same time Baba was clear about the value of working together. Babaji's spirit is echoed in the words of Martin Luther King Jr.: "We live in an inescapable web of mutuality." Babaji said time and again -in a hundred different ways: to work together in teams for the common good.

Because of my experience of Baba, and the gospel of Jesus, I have much concern about the world events. Wherever we may find ourselves politically, however, we can join together in praying for all the combatants and people who are affected by the war in Iraq.

## The Samaj Board speaks to War

Look to COMPASSION a place for all. Pro War and Anti War people believe they are "peacemakers". In this we all have common cause. BOTH views while expressing their "peacemaking" statements, may fall into perpetuating violence in their quest; violence of the heart, tongue, or fist.

Gandhi said: "We must become the change we seek." What the Babaji tradition shares with all faith traditions is a core of compassion. The fruit of our practice is compassion for the world, ourselves and others.

The Samaj Board wishes to affirm and nurture all relationships within our community. Because all relationships are important we as a Board stress the importance of compassion.

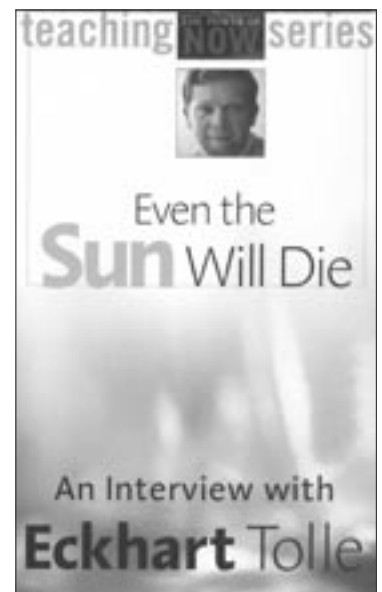

## Book Review:

**Practicing the Power of NOW**, by Eckhart Tolle. Essential teaching, meditations and exercises from the Power of NOW. Here is an essential and handy book for your library of spiritual practice. Pick it up any place and it will help transport you to the center of truth, love and simplicity that Babaji is about.

**Eckhart's tape set of:** Even the Sun Will Die, The Realization of Being, and Living the Liberated Life are also deeply inspirational. These are three 90-minute lectures or interviews that give many practical pointers to living a centered life. They are available in CD or cassette.

**The Battle for God:** A history of Fundamentalism by Karen Armstrong. This is a book that uncovers the theologies that are driving much of the world's politics at this time. Armstrong lives knowledgeably and well in all spiritual traditions. Dense but a great read.



# The Importance of Performing Fire Ceremonies

*This speech was given in Switzerland in May, 1985 by Vishnu Dutt Shastriji. Shastriji was the high priest at most fire ceremonies of Shri Babaji (Mahaprabhuji) and through Shastriji many of Babaji's teachings came. He is now 97 years old and is still an inspiration to all who visit him. With the upcoming Fire Ceremony Workshop, this seemed to be timely information.*

The incarnation of Lord Haidakhan Babaji has taken place to give the benefit of true knowledge and bliss to the whole world. With His infinite compassion and grace, Shri Mahaprabhuji remained with us for more than 5,700 days. During this time Babaji gave to us the ultimate root of the Vedic principles, which prevailed during the Treta Yuga (5000 years ago) and the Dvapara Yuga (2000 years ago), in a very simple manner. He made them available to the world, to the common man. He was the supreme Brahman but still came to us as a master in human form. Whatever He wanted his disciples and devotees to do, He Himself did and showed in a practical manner.

Shri Mahaprabhuji renewed the fire ceremony (yagna) which prevailed in ancient times. He demonstrated how to perform it and gave it to us in a very simple form since it had disappeared with the passage of time.

The law of nature, or life, is to give and take. A farmer may sow one seed in his field but in return he gets much more than what he has sown. That one grain of rice which he had sown will continue to give him tons and tons of rice.

And it would indeed be very selfish of us, if, when the Divine gives us so much food to pacify our hunger, gives us water to quench our thirst, that

we just keep on eating and drinking for our own selfish pleasure. But it is absolutely justified that when the Divine is giving so much, we should in return offer something back to the Divine. That's why we offer to the fire: when we receive so much grain to pacify the fires of hunger in our stomach, we should first offer from whatever we

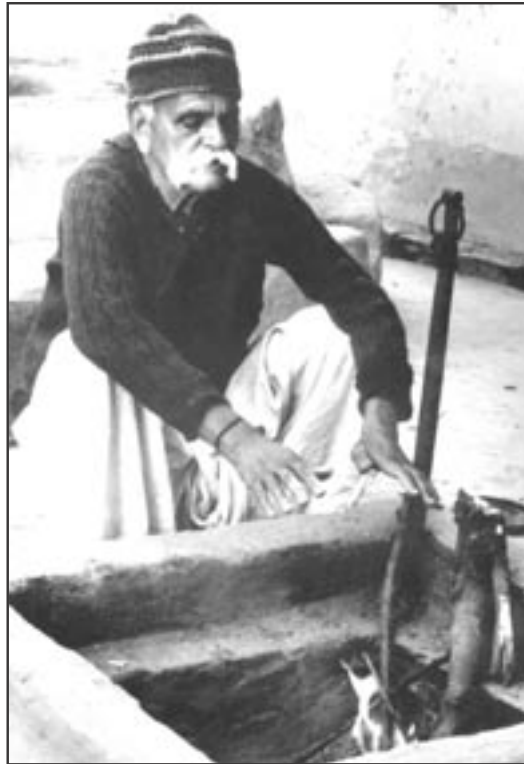
are earning, whatever we are receiving, a little offering to the fire to pacify it and also give food or offering to those people who are hungry, to pacify the fire of their hunger.

And that's why it's said that a person who does not offer anything to the fire in a yagna or to the hungry people, that he is eating his meal in a very sinful way because he is only concerned with his own selfish hunger, with his own self. That's why he or she can never reach the spiritual heights of the purity of soul.

Shri Babaji showed this to us as long as He was in His physical

body. He never took leave of the fire ceremony, everyday he performed it. Besides his daily yagnas, Shri Mahaprabhuji performed 171 very big yagnas in which hundreds of thousands of people came. He spent millions of rupees just on the fire ceremony and feeding the poor. Just as he performed the fire ceremony, the same way He satisfied the fire of people's hunger.

Shri Mahaprabhuji gave us the practical example. When He Himself, the Divine, performed the yagna and gave food to the poor people, this meant that common men should follow His example. By doing so, by giving food to the poor, to the hungry, by performing yagnas, you are doing good to your own soul. It is an act to bring peace, happiness and bliss, so follow the example of Shri Mahaprabhuji.

## Puja Workshop - Treasure Island, FL

What was the puja workshop like for me? An experience on two distinct levels. Firstly, on the most practical human level, I love to hangout with Babaji devotees! It is wonderful for me to feel the love and connection to my Babaji family, as well as to Baba himself. There is no better way to spend a weekend than joining in devotion via the Aarati services and fire ceremonies, as well as working and eating and laughing together. What joy! This workshop at Sharda and Jeffrey's was so much more than that. I have memories of beautiful clear skies and sunshine, wide white beaches, singing against a backdrop of blue water, parrots flying overhead and walking through an arbor of tropical flowers and vegetation on the way to and from our sleeping rooms which were fully equipped efficiency apartments. One evening, we even managed to stay up and watch a home video of the Kumbha Mela which was a real experience for those of us who had not attended. We had many informal stories from Pujari about his experiences with Babaji and some very informative educational, as well as practical, direction regarding the practice of puja.

On a second, deeper level, I am learning more about puja as a devotional practice. I am learning about it not only in my head but in my heart. After every workshop, I feel a little different inside – as if I am absorbing something very beautiful and it is becoming part of me. This is not something that can easily be described or taught – it is an experience of puja. It is something that fills me and for which I feel a deep gratitude. During the weekend, I felt everything drop away, leaving me totally in the present moment with this fullness and devotion. I am beginning to understand, with the help of this workshop, that puja is not just a daily routine like brushing my teeth or washing my face – it is a way of life. The elements of devotion, structure, discipline, and living consciously from moment to moment are ideally to be practiced at all times and not just during the puja ceremony. It is the ceremony though that creates the foundation for my life and is the constant reminder of how I want to live.

The Ashram and Samaj are providing a wonderful service to communities by offering these workshops, and I am so thankful to have been a part of this one.

On March 11 we had an alarming experience at the Ashram when Annelou, who volunteers here five days a week, had a stroke which affected her left side. The good news is that she has steadily recovered and is just about back to her normal routine.
